Delivering Fairham

Local developer CWC Group is working in partnership with Homes England to create an exemplar new neighbourhood for Nottingham that is safe, secure, sustainable and future-proof.

It is working with a range of bestin-class architects, designers and engineers to ensure Fairham meets the demands of both today and tomorrow.

The first phase of work will be based on creating a new access and road network across the 600 acres to serve the new residential areas as well as a separate entrance for Fairham Business Park.

The new homes at Fairham will be created by a selected mix of national and local housebuilders providing a broad mix of housing types all created with an emphasis on design and quality.

The development will be delivered in phases and is likely to take between 10-15 years to complete.

The next step will be the submission of detailed planning applications to deliver the new roads and site infrastructure as well as the first phase of employment and residential development.





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
